Public Announcement

Casper, Wyoming (October 5, 2017) – As part of the Casper Police Department’s “Our Community” Campaign, Interim Chief Steve Schulz is pleased to conduct a drone demonstration at 2pm at Lake McKenzie Dog Park (1691 Bryan Stock Trail) in Casper on October 11, 2017. The media and public are invited to attend.

This demonstration will highlight the added capability the Department now possesses for emergency response, public safety, and investigative purposes. Casper Fire EMS will also participate in the demonstration that will include a simulated water rescue.

Chief Schulz stated, “This drone, flown by FAA-licensed police officers, allows us to better understand and visualize the environment and situation before employing our officers and responders into high risk situations. Ultimately, both our officers and citizens are safer because of this new capability.”
