OUR COMMUNITY: BICYCLE DONATIONS TO NON-PROFITS

Public Announcement

Casper, Wyoming (November 6, 2017) – As part of the Casper Police Department’s “Our Community” Campaign, Interim Chief Steve Schulz is pleased to announce the Department’s bicycle donation program. This program allows community non-profit organizations to apply for and potentially receive unclaimed, recovered bicycles.

Casper area non-profit organizations are encouraged to apply for these bicycles using the form found at <https://casperpolice.org/bicycle-donation-application-form/>.

The application period closes at 5:00pm on Friday, December 1, 2017. A Department committee will allocate the bicycles based on the requests, and the bicycles can be picked up at the Casper Police Department between December 11 to December 13. These bicycles are “as-is” and are in used condition.

Chief Schulz stated, “Each year, the Department is unable to return many bicycles because the rightful owner doesn’t claim the stolen bike. We don’t want to see these bikes go to waste, and we know that many of our non-profit partners could put these bikes to great use. Thus, we’ve initiated this program, and we want the bicycles to be in the hands of our partners before Christmas.”
